

Annual Handicap Review

Since the introduction of the WHS (World Handicap System), the AHR can only be calculated by the respective golf associations, as the associations have assumed sovereignty over the handicap calculation.

AHR - Switzerland



Together with Swissgolf, PC CADDIE has created the possibility to load the proposals of the AHR calculation (Annual Handicap Review) from SwissGolf for further processing.

For the annual handicap review (AHR Annual Handicap Review), you can load the proposals for handicap changes from SwissGolf.

Start in PC CADDIE **Handicaps - Annual Handicap Review** or click the button  and in the further **Annual Handicap Review for members**

You will then immediately receive a list of suggestions from members for whom a handicap adjustment could be useful. Members for whom no change is necessary are not included in the list. The list can therefore be very short:
