PRO AM

Here, you can see an Example of a description from 2014 for a PRO AM (in German). Check to see which parts apply to your description, for example!

What is important for all of the following tips is that a pro also gets **a Pro in HCP** (and has no STV!)

You have to make sure that the tournament has 2 rounds, but with different participants in parts, for which certain players then get an overall score over 2 rounds (Pro over 36 holes). So that this can work, the tournament must be created as a 2-round tournament and exported to the club that is managing the 2nd round after the end of the 1st round. The **starting list must then be copied into the 2nd round**, and the necessary changes made only here.

This is the only way you can get matching score over 2 rounds!

Operation of the tournament

- Manage the 1st round in the 1st club as usual
- Load the starting list in the 2nd round! Select Load players with flight division
- Only remove players who have only played the 1st round now in the 2nd round and insert new players, that way, they get as many games as possible, if the players are still playing. This can still be done after exporting and importing the tournament to the next club.
- As soon as the 1st round is done, and you have transferred the players to the 2nd round, please export the tournament to the 2nd club.
- Import the intermediate results in the 2nd club.
- In the case there is another play change in the 2nd round, you can still manage this after exporting and importing, and adjust your starting list.
- Set the Team score for 2 rounds: *In the wizard, select: ProAm: Pro+2 best amateurs* in both rounds.
- It is important that the team numbers and team names are identical in both rounds; it is also
 important that you have loaded the starting list with the flight division from the 1st round to the
 2nd round beforehand. This simplifies putting the teams together for the team scores in the
 end. It may be useful to manually adjust the teams (team numbers and team names),
 depending on how many player changes you had, and if several pros are playing for the same
 team.


Creating a tournament

Basic settings


Match type and scoring system

Set the tournament to "Singles" and "HCP good:Stroke play - up: Stableford" and manage the tournament as usual! The pros play stroke play and are also scored by the stroke play system.

In Austria, please use the "Finished combinations: Pro-Am" option.




Multiple courses in the tournament



HCP limits of the tees


Make sure that the set HCP limits of the tees are appropriate for every player:

In Prizes/Categories, set the singles prize for the pros. The prize should look like this:




Setting team scores

It is important that team score is set the same for both rounds!


For the team score, select the following settings in round 1 as well as round 2 on the **Wizard** button. Let the team result be determined with Stableford so that the pros' stroke play results get converted.




Also pay great attention to the further notes in the following screenshots!



Also, in the team score, select the following under **Special scoring** after the teams are put together:




Set the following setting and confirm with OK! Repeat this for both rounds, always after putting a team together with the wizard!



Printing team scores

You print the team score directly on the "Team score" button. You print the 1st round as usual. The individual results for each hole are displayed. The results that count are presented *in bold*.

If you only want to print the team result for the 2nd round, untick the "Overall list" box:



Team result on the Internet

If you want to present the team results *individually after each round* on the Internet, you can upload the PDFs of the team score of the individual rounds or copy the 2-round tournament into 2 individual tournaments at the end of the tournament to present the team scores of each individual round on the Internet.

If you activate the team results in the 2-round tournament for online presentation, the team results for both rounds are then combined.
